- the diplomatic service and diplomatic institutions of Ukraine;
- The National Security and Defence Council of Ukraine and other state bodies in the field of national security and foreign policy of Ukraine;
- Ukraine's participation in the international security system;
- European and North Atlantic integration of Ukraine;
- bilateral foreign policy relations of Ukraine;
- Ukraine and international organisations;
- protection of the rights of Ukrainian citizens abroad.
