The program of the academic discipline «International Commercial Arbitration» is compiled in accordance with the educational and professional program of preparation for the second (master's) level of higher education in the field of knowledge 29 International Relations, specialty 293 International Law.

The purpose of teaching the academic discipline is to master the main theoretical aspects of the legal regulation of the procedure for considering disputes by international commercial arbitration, practical skills and abilities to determine the competence of arbitration to consider disputes, determine the law that should be applied by arbitration to resolve a dispute, and the law in accordance with which arbitration considers disputes.
