The program of the discipline "**Law of International Organizations**" is drawn up in accordance with the educational and professional program of preparation of the master, subject area 29 International relations, specialty 293 International Law.

The purpose the discipline: mastering certain tools of the field of law of international organizations, studying its essence, principles and sources; paying attention to the activities of international intergovernmental organizations of a universal, regional, sub-regional nature; determining the place and role of international non-governmental organizations in modern international relations.

Description of the discipline: concept, subject, sources of law of international organizations, principles of activity, classification of international organizations, legal personality of international organizations, "internal law" of international organizations, status of bodies of organizations and their officials, grounds, types and forms of liability of international organizations, status of employees of international organizations, procedure for resolving internal disputes and disciplinary cases, legal nature of non-governmental international organizations, grounds for functioning, purpose of creation, types.
